RULES OF CONDUCT

NOTE: Candidates should read the declaration carefully before signing it at the time of admission and honour it.

1. Strict punctuality should be observed. Students coming late will not be permitted into the lecture Hall.
2. Students are forbidden to loiter in the college building during the working hours.
3. No Notice or intimation shall be put up by students in the college on the notice board or in the college premises. Students should refrain from writing on the walls of the college or scribbling on the walls. They should co-operate in keeping the college premises neat and clean.
